**Chelli Westengaard, OTR** is the Lead Occupational Therapist for the Feeding and Swallowing Department at Children's Hospital and has worked as a feeding specialist at Children's Hospital for the past 4 years and in pediatrics for the past 9 years.

**Heather Young, OTR** is a rehabilitation therapist who works at Children's Hospital West Village Pointe satellite outpatient clinic and has worked in pediatrics for the past 12 years.

Chelli and Heather complete feeding evaluations using Video Swallow studies to determine safety of swallowing and Clinical Feeding Evaluations. They also provide follow up treatment of feeding issues including oral aversions, transitioning from G-tube feeding to oral eating, and progression of feeding using the developmental food continuum.
